# Message from President September 2021

Thank you to Deborah who 'manned' both the catalog table and managed to mentor at least 3 judges simultaneously! Her donation of hand sanitizers in each catalog gift bag was very timely.

A huge congratulation goes out to our club members for their wins at the Specialty and the beautiful rosettes and trophies. The Challenge Trophy has been retired. I heard Robert had guarded that trophy after their win. Congrats to Betty and Robert!

Another item prior to the Specialty, the Board clarified criteria for winning the high scoring trophy this year and we need to expand on the criteria for it for future shows at our next meeting. There was no one who qualified this year for it.

For 2022 and future we need to better define the old motion for High Scoring Champion. This year we had only a Beginner Novice entry. Typically High Scoring is given to the eligible dog from a Regular Obedience Class (Novice, Open or Utility). Also now that AKC has added Rally, we may want to consider an equivalent for Rally entrants.
